B. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Visa Formalities

2. Vaccinations

All travellers are required to show their International Certificate of Vaccination for yellow fever.

3. Language

Dutch is the official language in Suriname. English is widely understood in the hotels and shops and used as a second language in commerce.

4. Electricity Supply

The standard voltage is 110 V and the standard frequency is 60 Hz. The power sockets used are depicted.









5. Climate

Tropical with high humidity. The average temperature is 28° C (80° F). There is a short dry season from February to April, a long rainy season from May to mid August, a long dry season from mid August to November and a short rainy season from December to January.

6. Currency

The Surinamese Dollar (SRD) is the unit of currency. Euro and US Dollar are also partly accepted. USD \$1.00 is equivalent to approximately SRD \$7.43. USD can be exchanged at banks or currency exchange all over Paramaribo. The major credit cards, such as MasterCard and Visa, are accepted at the major hotels, some commercial banks and a few of the larger shops. It is advisable to travel with a small amount of cash.

7. Departure Tax

Departure tax is included in the cost of the airline ticket.

8. Business Hours

Most commercial banks are open from Monday- Friday from 07:30- 14:00 hrs, and some banks are open on Saturday as well.
