

## CARIBIX and Caribbean IXP Proliferation Collaborations



#### Project effective date 1st January 2021

- Key Activities:
- Capacity building and training on the evolution of the IXPs, their features, services, and role in the national development;
- Training on developing a content creation industry;
- Development of a governance mechanism for the IXPs;
- Engagement of Stakeholders;
- Implementation of the IXP infrastructure;
- Facilitation of interconnection with the other IXPs;
- Establishing the basis for a local content industry.







Saint-Barthélemy is to create an internet exchange point on the island which is intended to improve the reliability and service experience of the operators and users of the telecommunications network



Guadeloupe and the association of Guadeloupe Tech is to create a simple and inexpensive tool to identify and route the internet traffic of the territory locally



Saint Martin and Sint Maarten is to create a digital bridge and connectivity to the existing Sint Maarten IXP, establishing one 'geographic unit' which will facilitate easy inter island traffic exchange








### **IXP Governance Perspectives**

#### Q3: Is there an IXP oversight team?





#### Q5: Is there a written peering agreement?



## Growth and Sustainability of IXP Operations:




Q6: How many types of participants are connected to your IXP?








 Q9: Are any of the following indicators used to aid in tracking the growth and impact of your IXP?



## **IXP Peering Dynamics:**


#### Q11: Is there a written peering agreement?


